

## **Village Of Homer Notification**

## No Glass Containers are allowed in your Recycling Container Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2020

If you want to recycle Glass containers you need to bring your glass to the Cortland county recycling center. See Cortland County recycling center information guide lines enclosed.

- Plastic bags are <u>NOT ALLOWED</u> in the recycling carts. <u>Don't bag your</u> recyclables
- Please place ALL recyclables into the cart loosely Breakdown All Boxes
- Please bag all trash and place into trash cart
- Please follow the cart placement instructions below

Wednesday, January 15th & Thursday January 16th 2020 Syracuse Haulers will be using an automated arm Split body trash and recycling style truck to service the village of Homer. The truck will pick up at the same time your trash and recycling carts. Please have both containers out at the same time



Please place carts out the night before or by 7:00am at the curbside as you have in the past on your pickup day. Please place the carts with the handle facing your home. Please separate these carts at least five feet from one another (See Image 1), or each at opposite sides of your driveway as shown below. (See image 2) All trash & recycling to be picked up must be placed in the appropriate container, not on the ground. Please do not attempt to crush down the contents and over pack the container as this will lead to issues when trying to empty the containers into the trucks.

All cardboard boxes must be broken down. All recycling materials can be mixed together in the recycling cart – NO GLASS CONTAINERS. These carts have serial numbers for tracking purposes and will be maintained by Syracuse Haulers for all normal wear and tear (a wheel falling off, lid hinge breakage, body cracks etc.) which would result in replacement or repair by Syracuse Haulers. Please be sure to keep track of this equipment and report any wear and tear to Syracuse Haulers at (315) 426–6771.
