March 2020 Monthly report

Date: March 27, 2020

For the time period: 02/26/20 - 03/26/20

Mayor and members of the board,

Patrol Monthly Activities:

Please refer to the attached detailed reports for last month. There were a total of 338 calls for service during the month of March. Officers made 1 arrest during the time frame of this report and it was for driving while intoxicated. They conducted a total of 29 vehicle and traffic stops, which resulted in 4 traffic tickets being issued. They also invest gated 7 motor vehicle collisions all of which involved property damage only.

Notable investigations or incidents during the month of March: criminal mischief investigation involving damage to a residence and vehicle; criminal mischief investigation where the same vehicle was damaged twice over two separate nights; a criminal mischief investigation involving damage to a residence and a report of larceny of medication.

School Officers Reports:

Please refer to the attached detailed school resource officer's report for the month of March 2020. There was a total of 239 incidents that the resource officers were involved in during the month of March.

Recent updates:

Security cameras updates: No issues with the current cameras during the month of March. The camera system at the police department was upgraded by Beard Electric in February and there have been no issues with it. The new system has the ability to add additional cameras and I am obtaining a quote from Beard Electric for exterior cameras at the police department.

Patrol vehicle updates: No issues with the patrol vehicles regarding regular maintenance. However, there was a minor issue with the lock to the driver's side door to 226 (2020 Ford Explorer) where the key will not unlock it. This has been an issue with this model and the part to repair it is on back order (expected March 31st). The new patrol vehicle to replace 126 (2017 Ford Taurus) was ordered on March 4, 2020. VanBortel Ford was not able to provide me with a projected delivery date for the new vehicle.

Grant updates: The 2021 traffic safety grants were announced on March 2, 2020. I will be applying for a new traffic safety grant over the next few weeks. On March 20, 2020, consistent with the guidance from Governor Cuomo and the New York State Health Department to reduce the community spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee (GTSC) has cancelled or postponed all events. Therefore, we will not be conducting initiatives in April such as Distracted Driving Enforcement Mobilization and the No Empty Chair enforcement.

Officers are taking the proper precautions to slow or stop the spread of the virus. They have been directed to clean the patrol vehicles with disinfectant at the start and end of their shifts as well as any work areas inside the police department. They have also been advised to practice social distancing on calls or while speaking to people. Officers also have personal protection equipment (N95 masks, latex gloves and safety glasses/goggle), but our supplies are limited, and they are excersing good judgment as when they need to use them.

Due to the virus, all court proceedings in New York State have been postposed with exception of arraignments for qualifying offenses, such as serious/violent offenses, domestics or order of protection violations, which will be conducted at one location (county courthouse). However, the 6th Judicial Court has been trying to establish the means of doing these arraignments remotely. As it pertains to arrests that do not need immediate arraignment, Town of Homer Justice Foley has agreed for officers to file paperwork with the court and he (Justice Foley) will issue a criminal summons for a date sometime in May or when the courts commences again. By doing this it will minimize possible exposure to the officer as well as taking the person into the jail to be processed.

In conclusion, I would like to remind residents that they can help slow or stop the spread of the virus by following the recommendations of social distancing and not to gather in groups. I would like residents to know that if we receive a complaint that someone is not following the social distancing recommendations or the governor's executive order and an officer responds, to be considerate and understand that we are trying to help save lives while trying not to become infected ourselves, and to cooperate with the officer. We will continue to provide police services to the best of our ability. Our officer's health and safety, along with their families and everyone else is of an upmost priority. This crisis may last several weeks, if not months, we are asking residents to be patient and understanding and remember, we are all in this together.
