

## **Help Wanted!**

The Village of Homer is looking to hire seasonal laborers, MEO's, and a full-time permanent laborer in the water/sewer department. Applications are available in the Village Office.

### **Seasonal Laborers/ MEOS in DPW:**

The Village is hiring season laborers and MEO's on a full-time or part-time basis to work hours ranging from 7 am to 5 PM Monday thru Saturday. Laborers and MEO's must be able to lift fifty pounds or more. Experience with concrete or previous work on sidewalks is a plus. Laborers and MEOS must also be willing to weed, trim, and cut lawns using motorized push mowers and/or lawn mowers. Brush, leaves, and yard clippings are picked up on designated days by the Village MEO's and laborers. During road projects, a laborer or MEO's may be used to drive vehicles, flag, or rake or shovel asphalt. During the sidewalk projects, laborers or MEO's may be used to lay forms, pour cement, or shovel. Other duties of laborers and MEO's include loading and unloading trucks, cleaning debris from parking lots and culverts, as well as cleaning vehicles and buildings. Individuals may be assigned daily to work in differing areas of the Village under the direction of the Superintendent of Streets and Parks.

### **Permanent Full-time Laborer or MEO in Water and Sewer Department:**

The Village is hiring one full-time laborer or MEO in the water and sewer department. Individual must be able/willing to work in the sewers, around human feces. The individual's respective duties will be to check sewer pump stations hours, and help pull pumps if clogged. Additionally, the individual will help repair all water mains and water pump stations. Also, the individual will assist in the construction and repair of sewer lines, manholes, and catch basins. MEO's in the water and sewer department will need a class B Driver's license. All water and sewer department employees will need to be able to lift 50 pounds repeatedly, remain in crouched down positions for a long time, perform physical labor, such as patching streets, painting, and pouring cement. MEO's operate motorized equipment to assist in street maintenance, construction, and repair. Individual must learn to take samples of water for water testing.
