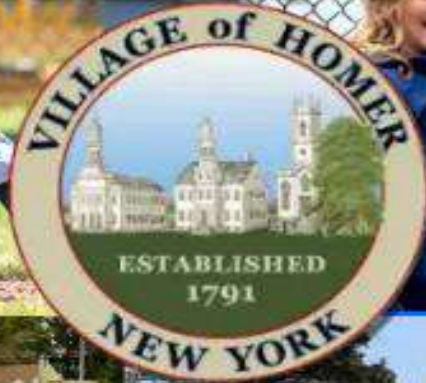

Albert J. Durkee Memorial Park

Located on Route 11, 1/2 mile north of the center of the Village. Durkee Park has a pavilion, picnic facilities, playground and a fishing dock in a beautiful setting for the whole family to enjoy.

Harry A. Calale Park

Located on West Road (Route 281) before Prospect Street. This facility is used for softball, tee-ball, football and lacrosse.

George Venum Memorial Park

Located on Main Street, behind Homer Recreation Department office, next to Homer Fire Station. This facility provides a lighted basketball court and off-street parking.

Griggs Memorial Field

Located on Hudson Street behind Newton Water Works, this facility has playing fields for baseball and softball. It is the home field of Homer Little League and Tee-ball.

Newton Park

Located on the corner of Cayuga Street and Bartlett Avenue, three blocks west of Main Street. This park has a new (2019) neighborhood play structure area with swings, adaptive swings, slides, and benches.

LEARN TO SWIM PROGRAM
AT THE CORTLAND Y.W.C.A.

Registration will open for 2 weeks only. Monday, May 27 to Friday June 7th. Class size is limited to **15 Max** and advanced registration and parental permission is **REQUIRED**. Open to Village of Homer, Town of Homer, and Town of Cortlandville residents only.

AGES 5-15

Registration will be available to non-residents after the first 2 weeks of registration for \$10.

There are two 4-week sessions. Classes are Monday-Friday.

Session 1: **July 1-July 26. Class will not be held on July 4.**

Session 2: **July 29-August 23.**

Level 1: 11:00-11:30

Level III: 11:30-12:00

Level IV, V & VI: 11:30-12:00

SWIM LESSON LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

The following skills will be taught during the 4-week session. Swimmers must pass all skills to move to the next level.

Level 1: Students are introduced and work on elementary skills. Blowing bubbles, opening eyes under water, front, back floats, and glides. Alternating and simultaneous arm and leg movements on front and back are also introduced. All skills are done with the support of instructor.

Level 2: Students need less support. Front and back glides with kicks are taught and combined arm and leg action on front for 5 body lengths. Students work on fully submerging and holding breath and front floats for 5 seconds. Students open their eyes under water and retrieve objects. Treading water is introduced and exploration of deep end.

Level 3: Front and back glides are unsupported. Front and back crawl become more accomplished. Rotary breathing for front crawl, dolphin kick and elementary back stroke will be introduced. Students will be able to jump in the deep end and diving (from knee) will be introduced. Students will increase their time of treading water to 30 seconds. Lessons will be in the deep end.

Level 4: Instruction includes coordinating front crawl (25 yards), backstroke (15yards), elementary backstroke (25 yards), breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly (15 yards). Dives are done from a standing position. Level 5: Shallow angle dives from the side are introduced. Flip turns for front crawl and backstroke are worked while swimming. All stroke distances (except front crawl and elementary backstroke, 50 yards), are increased to 25 yards. Treading water is increased to 5 minutes. Level 6 Strokes are perfected and done with flip turns. 100 yards of front crawl and elementary backstroke. 50 yards for back crawl, breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Feet first tuck and pike surface dives are taught. Treading water using only a kick for 2 minutes and survival swimming for 10 minutes.

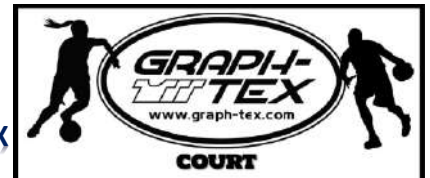


