RESOLUTION TO SCHEDULE A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE VILLAGE OF HOMER INTENT TO APPLY FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING FOR A NEW NEWTON WATERWORKS WATER TANK

WHEREAS the Village of Homer (Village) intends to submit an application to the New York State Office of Homes and Community Renewal for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for the 2025 program year; and

WHEREAS, the State of New York has announced that up to \$24.2 million is available through the 2025 CDBG Program, with up to \$20 million specifically available for public infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS the Village is considering submitting an application for up to \$2 million in CDBG funds to support a new Newton Waterworks Water Tank (Water Tank); and

WHEREAS, as part of the application process, the Village must hold a public hearing to gather input from citizens, public agencies, and other stakeholders on the proposed CDBG application, community needs, and CDBG funding priorities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Trustees (Board) hereby schedules a public hearing to be held on Tuesday, July 22nd 2025, at the regular Board meeting time to receive public comments on the Village's proposed CDBG application for a Water Tank; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Clerk will publish a notice of said public hearing in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
